Second Scripture Reading John 5:1-15 Elder Tom Perloff After this there was a feast of the Jews, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. ² Now there is in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate a pool, in Hebrew called Beth-za'tha, [a] which has five porticoes. ³ In these lay a multitude of invalids, blind, lame, paralyzed. [b] ⁵ One man was there, who had been ill for thirty-eight years. ⁶ When Jesus saw him and knew that he had been lying there a long time, he said to him, "Do you want to be healed?" ⁷ The sick man answered him, "Sir, I have no man to put me into the pool when the water is troubled, and while I am going another steps down before me." ⁸ Jesus said to him, "Rise, take up your pallet, and

walk." ⁹ And at once the man was healed, and he took up his pallet and walked.
