The book is the 2014 memoir by American attorney Bryan Stevenson that documents his career defending disadvantaged clients. The book was awarded the 2015 Dayton Literary Peace Prize for Nonfiction, as well as the 2015 Andrew Carnegie Medal for Excellence in Nonfiction and the 2015 NAACP Image Award for Outstanding Literary Work in Nonfiction. It was adapted as a 2019 movie. We will discuss through the end of Chapter 3 at our August 6 meeting.
