The Family Giving Tree | School Supplies Needed June-July 9 (earlier welcomed and encouraged)
Grade levels: K-2, 3-5, and 6-12

Thanks to all who have participated so far in pledging or bringing school supplies or backpacks! We are off to a good start, with 11 of 35 supply components pledged, and 9 of the 12 backpacks needed pledged. This week, we hope to continue the momentum so we can reach our goal of donating 12 school supply kits for low-income students by July 9.

Items range in cost from about \$5 for some supplies, and up to \$30 for a backpack (shop sales to save on all items). You can take multiple tags for a group of items, if you are able to give a little more, or team up with a friend to split costs, if you are shopping for more expensive items. To shop for supplies, take the appropriate tag(s), and as a tip take a photo of the tag(s) in case they get misplaced. Tags, information, and the boxkette are all located together in the church narthex.

Once you have your items in hand, please place them in the boxkette in the narthex, no later than Sunday July 9, so we have time to assemble the completed kits before the delivery date.
